CPSA Summer Recess Report

AB 1035 (Ramos) COVID-19 emergency: small businesses: immunity from civil liability.

Summary: This bill would exempt a small business with 25 or fewer employees from liability for an injury or illness to a person due to coronavirus (COVID-19) based on a claim that the person contracted COVID-19 while at that small business, or due to the actions of that small business.

AB 2999 (Low) Employees: bereavement leave.

Summary: This bill would enact the Bereavement Leave Act of 2020 to require an employer to grant an employee up to 10 business days of unpaid bereavement leave upon the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, grandparent, grandchild, or domestic partner, in accordance with certain procedures, and subject to certain exclusions.

A Message from Monte...

The Phantom Leak

Occasionally, American Leak Detection Sacramento is called out to find a pool leak but...it isn't a leak at all. There are times that the auto-fill canister float isn't set correctly, which results in water being constantly added to a pool.

Capital Valley IPSSA members know as well as anyone that when water is constantly added to a pool, the chemicals get diluted and makes the pool appear to have a leak. Obviously, if the auto-fill supply line is turned off and the water level drops (exceeding regular evaporation) there is a leak and a leak detection appointment should be scheduled. But, if the auto supply line is shut and there is no water loss, an adjustment to the float could be in order. Also, overflow pipes can also be set incorrectly in the auto fill canister, allowing water to leak down lower than is necessary.

Overflow lines that are set below the water line on the pool wall, and have an anti-siphon loop in the pipe, can sometimes fail to break the siphon and continue to lower the level of the pool. This scenario is more likely to occur if there is an intense rainstorm and the water level in the pool rises very quickly, not allowing the anti-siphon loop to work correctly.

Household Bleach [Sodium Hypochlorite] Can Be Used for Disinfecting Home Surfaces, according to the CDC

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends the following for homes to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.*

Clean and Disinfect

- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them. Use detergent or soan and water prior to disinfection.
- Then, use a household disinfectant. Most common EPA-registered household disinfectants will work.

Industrial and swimming pool strength versions of bleach, such as HASA Sani-Clor[®] and Hasachlor[®], can be used at different dilutions to s as effective disinfectants for indoor surfaces.

Did you know?

Surface Sanitization

Diluted household bleach solutions may be used if appropriate for the surface.

- Check the label to see if your bleach is intended for disinfection, and ensure the product is not past its expiration date. Some bleaches, such as those designed for safe use on colored clothing or for whitening, may not be suitable for disinfection.
- Unexpired household bleach will be effective against coronaviruses when properly diluted.
- A lways follow the manufacturer's instructions for application and proper ventilation. Never mix household bleach with ammonia or any other cleanser.
- Leave solution on the surface for at least 1 minute.





How to Make a Bleach Disinfecting Solution 💒

According to CDC Recommend

Mix 5 tablespoons (1/3 cup) bleach per gallon of water OR 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water.

lar household bleach is liquid sodium hypochlorite and is available in several strengths for many household and industrial uses.* The CDC recommendation for making a disinfecting solution assumes a 6% strength household bleach.

HASA Sani-Clor is a 12.5% strength sodium hypochlorite bleach that has been used in swimming pools to sanitize and disinfect since 1964. It consists of the same mole bought household bleach. The difference is that it is manufactured at a higher concentration. It can be used to make a disinfection solution for indoor use as recommended by the CDC

The CDC recommended bleach doses shown above would simply be cut in half to make the bleach solution from 12.5% sodium hypochlorite. For best results, always follow the EPA registered label instructions for the product that is used for dilution


