REQUEST FOR GRASSROOTS ACTION!!! Oppose Service Tax Proposals

Last week, SPEC sent out an Alert informing members that two bills were introduced in the California State Legislature that would establish a tax on pool service by adding sales tax to the monthly billing for such services.

AB 1963, by Assemblywoman Alyson Huber, would impose a blanket 4% tax on all services, except for medical, educational, auto repair, tax preparation, legal and agricultural services.

The second measure, AB 2540 by Assemblyman Gatto, specifically names "pool maintenance" as a one of the target list of 27 services where state sales tax would be imposed. To comply with the bill, pool service professionals would be required to add sales tax to their monthly invoices for pool services.

"These two proposed bills are sure to garner a lot of opposition from those that provide the 27 services targeted by this legislation," said John A. Norwood, President of SPEC. "Pool and spa professionals have been targeted by these bills. SPEC and the service industry need a strong showing in opposition to defeat these ill conceived measures."

AB 2540 is currently scheduled to be heard in the Assembly Revenue & Taxation Committee on April 9th. AB 1963 is also awaiting hearing in this committee.

SPEC is strongly opposed to both of these measures and needs YOUR help. We are asking pool service professionals and their employees to write a letter to Assemblymembers Huber and Gatto registering your opposition. In addition, send a letter to the members of the Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee if you live or work in the district of one of the members of this committee.

SPEC has provided two templates for you to use in writing your letter. Please try to add as many details as possible to make the letter more personal. In addition, it is very important for you to let them know if you are a constituent (live in their district). For your convenience, attached to this Alert is a list of all of the members of the committee and their contact information. You will also find templates for letters attached

"Ideally we can generate hundreds of letters of opposition to the legislators on this committee," stated Terry Snow, SPEC Board member and IPSSA representative. "Contact from district constituents can sway a legislator's vote. It is very important that you ACT NOW! This is an important issue that affects YOUR business," continued Snow.

2012 California Service Tax Legislation

Service Tax Bills

AB 1963 (Huber)

This bill would impose a 4-percent state sales and use tax on services, except for medical, educational, automobile repair, tax preparation, legal and agricultural services. This bill would also reduce the state sales and use tax rate on retailers for the sale of tangible personal property from 6 ¼% to 4%. The bill would also reduce the personal income tax rate from 9.3% of the amount over \$32,600 to 2.75% for incomes below \$56,000 and 6.5% for income above \$56,000. The standard personal deduction for a single taxpayer would be increased from \$1,880 to \$25,000 and for the head of household from \$3,760 to \$45,000. This bill would take effect on January 1, 2013.

AB 2540 (Gatto)

This bill would expand the sales and use tax base to include 27 specified categories of services. "Pool maintenance" is one of the 27 specified services. This bill would also exclude from taxable income an amount equal to 20 percent of the business income of a personal income taxpayer, not to exceed \$10,000.

I am writing to you in opposition to AB 1963. AB 1963 would apply the California sales tax to the swimming pool service industry.

For all of these reasons, I am opposed to adding the sales tax to pool maintenance service and request your "NO" vote on this important bill when it is heard in your committee.
