

In last month's newsletter, I wrote about using companies from our chapter for referral work you may not have expertise or time to provide to your own customers. Specifically I asked that you use the resource manual that Mike Assenza put together. Mike researched the members that turned in the info to be included on this list and made sure Contractor licenses were in good standing and worked off a current member roster of up to date IPSSA insured members. From that manual or not, insurances can lapse anytime for any reason. Please make sure whomever you use is properly licensed and carries insurance that is still current and the policy covers the scope of work being performed. Please ask them for a certificate of insurance. Many of the companies in our chapter will have no problem with this and we all have IPSSA insurance at this time. Which, IPSSA will provide these certificates when asked usually that day, by the insured member. We have had some cancellations in the past from members for nonpayment who will still attend meetings just to keep getting work. Please be careful. By the way if you are canceled you can avoid the fine penalty if you sign up for auto pay. You only get this once, the next time the fine is automatic. You will have to also now sign and return a letter declaring you had no losses during your lapse in coverage. This is a new policy set forth by Arrow insurance. Please pay your insurance bills on time. It is worth having auto pay set up with IPSSA financial. Sue Neronde works very hard to make sure everybody stays current. I get a list of who is behind every month. You know who you are. By the time I get the list you are within a day or two of being canceled and losing your coverage. Which is horrible if you have a loss that insurance would have covered.

Check with Linda Eggers membership, Sue Neronde or myself to see if your beneficiary form has been filled out and turned in. Update any changes to your beneficiary forms with Sue Neronde. Such as marriages divorce or new children. You wouldn't want that beneficiary money going to the wrong place or nowhere at all.

The weather has been giving us rain and some days it seems abundant. I think it is alleviating some of the worries, but we are still going to fall short this season of enough rain. 
